



Environmental Policy Statement

The Wernick Group companies are involved in the design, manufacture, refurbishment and installation of modular buildings with associated construction activities.

Group companies are committed to minimising impacts and risks to the environment arising from activities and to the conservation and improvement of the environment in line with ISO14001:2015.

In order to achieve these aims, operations will be managed in ways which are environmentally sustainable and economically feasible in line with the following key objectives:

- To promote sound management policies and practices throughout the Group which facilitate complying with relevant legislation as a minimum standard;
- By ensuring that established methods of monitoring prevent pollution and lead to continual improvements in overall performance;
- Objectives and targets will be implemented and reviewed;
- Energy and water will be used responsibly and efficiently;

- Production of waste will be minimised as far as is reasonably practicable by reuse and recycling where appropriate and regulated disposal of residual waste;

- Maintenance activities will be undertaken in environmentally sensitive ways;
- The environmental impact of decommissioning and disposal of assets will be minimised;
- Performance will be measured and communicated internally and made available to external interested parties;
- Environmental impact awareness will be raised by promotion of individual good practice of staff and contractors;
- Current and future business decisions will take environmental factors and the impact on our Environmental Management System into consideration.

Responsibility for implementation of this Policy rests with Group management teams and the Director responsible for Health, Safety and Environment. This Policy will be reviewed on an annual basis and revised as necessary.

The Wernick Group Environmental Management System and associated policies and procedures apply to and will be utilised by the operating companies namely: Wernick Buildings, Wernick Construction, Wernick Hire, Wernick Events and Wernick Refurbished Buildings.
