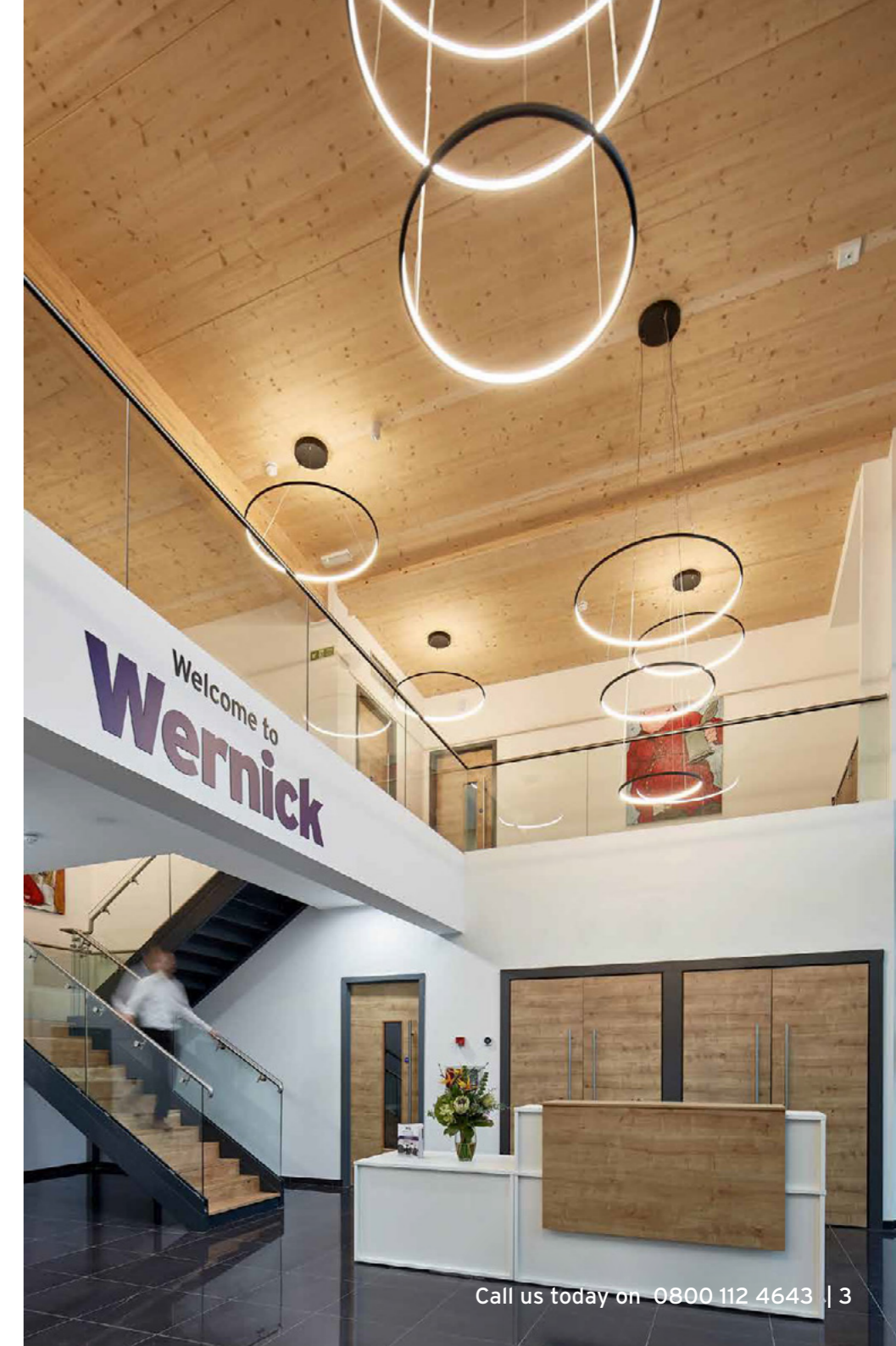

Refurbishment timeline

Procurement

The process begins by bringing pre-owned modular buildings into our 8.5 acre refurbishment site based at York.

We only procure buildings that feature a full steel frame in order to provide the very best starting conditions for refurbishment.

Inspection

A full inspection under controlled factory conditions is carried out to ensure the building meets our industry leading standards.

Delivery and installation

We use trusted haulage companies to transport the building 'modules' to site. Once transported the modules are installed by our specialist installation teams and can be water-tight in just one day.

Stripping

Upon order, our experienced refurbishment team take the selected modules back to their original steel frame. This work includes, but is not limited to, removing existing external and internal walls, floor, roofing elements, doors, windows, electrics, plumbing and heating.

Refurbishing

Working to an agreed drawing and specification, our team build a brand new building upon the re-purposed steel frame. All materials used in the construction are 100% new and bespoke to our clients requirements.

Completion and handover

Our installation teams complete the internal and external works to finish the building on site. Once all works are finished the building will be handed over to you to allow you to move into your new building.
